GoDaddy and other providers have stopped providing these methods as well as they adopt O365 as their native platform.

Developers must now connect to these servers with modern OAuth connections which are more secure than POP and IMAP. Sending email is also evolving. Each of these platforms now provide direct API methods to send mail as well.

RedHorse has long supported 2-factor authentication with POP and IMAP and now adds a direct connection to Gmail and O365 using their recommended OAuth2 methods for both inbound and outbound email.
